An interesting feature of this service is that you do not need to install the app for the basic benefit of mass texting, since it is capable of sending texts to your phone's default messaging app. However, during testing there was an instance where I received a group message via the app, but didn't see it in my phone's default app. I've not read of this "glitch", and don't know if it's related to my phone, settings, or because I've set GroupMe to send texts to both of my apps (for testing purposes). The group now has 10 members, which will help with the evaluation. For a while yet, we will continue to also send texts via the old method/list. Of course, I will let you know if/when the old list is to be discontinued. If you'd like to be added to the GroupMe list, just let me know. Since it is a 3rd party service, I will not add you without your approval/request.
