At this point, I will assume that all members who intend to remain in our club this year have submitted their dues. **Anyone who has not paid will be removed from the club roster and communications** in June ("Guest" communications will still be received unless you request to be removed from the email list). If you plan to maintain your membership, but have not paid, please let me know ASAP!

The **field** has been mowed a couple times now without issue. The roller has not yet been filled with water, so don't worry about rolling at this time. There is a clipboard with sign-in sheet just inside the shed (front left corner). If you mow, log the date on this sheet.

The rain has finally let up just enough for the field to start drying. On days it doesn't rain, the access lane has been solid enough for most vehicles, and the parking area is mostly dry. But to make it easier to get back there, Bill recently cut a fresh path outside of the lane ruts, so we may be able to avoid any potential mud puddles.

That said, the ground under the textile runway is still quite soft and has developed some mild bumpiness. Until the ground solidifies, please don't walk on the runway any more than necessary. We may attempt to roll this area, but must be careful not to add bumps or ruts in the process.

Jim Kingsley installed a heavy duty **latch on the shed**, moved the padlock to this latch, and changed the combination (to be provided in follow-up member email). This allows for direct access to the shed – without having to open the frequency management box first – which is more convenient and faster in case of emergency.

We made our last payment to Bill for the shed, so we no longer carry any debt!

The **EAA** (Experimental Aircraft Association) will be holding an event at Huron's *Hind Airport* on Saturday, June 15th, and would like **LZRC to participate by displaying & flying our model aircraft!** We will have access to 500 ft. of runway. They are also providing a flight line barrier, hangar space (if weather doesn't cooperate), tables for displays, and burgers & hot dogs. We can set up any time after 8:30 AM, and fly between 11 AM - 2 PM. If you participate, you might consider bringing a pop-up canopy & chair. The Boy Scouts are expected to attend, which gives us a great opportunity to promote our club & hobby. The more the merrier, and the greater the variety the better. So, please consider coming out to display some aircraft, fly something, or just show your support and spend the day among friends & other enthusiasts!

Due to recent rain and the forecast, our **June 1st Fun Fly is canceled**. Also, scheduling conflicts prompted us to **change the dates for subsequent Fun Flies this summer**. They are now planned for **July 20** and **August 24**.
